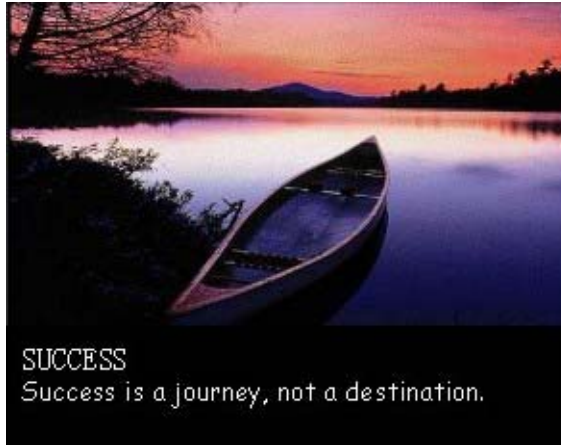

NEW – Diploma in Business Administration
